YOUTH HIGHLIGHT

During the 100 Deadliest Days between Memorial Day and Labor Day, teens face increased risks on the road due to distractions and passenger influence.

Connecticut has specific driving laws for teens to follow, including:

- Teens can only drive alone or with a licensed adult over 20 when they first get their license.
- After 6 months, they can drive with immediate family members.
- Driving is restricted to 5 A.M. to 11 P.M., with some exceptions.
- All device use, including hands-free phones and GPS, is prohibited.

Parents should lead by example, set boundaries, and discuss consequences to promote safe driving habits. Adhering to these laws can reduce crashes and fatalities among teens during the summer months.
